I hereby waive and release Urban Hound, Inc. from any and all liability of any nature for any injury, death or loss of my dog resulting from Urban Hound, Inc.'s actions or from the action of my dog or any other dog while in the custody of, or on the grounds, or surrounding area of urban Hound, Inc. In the event my dog causes injury to another dog or to a person while at daycare, I agree to indemnify and subrogate Urban Hound, Inc. from any action which may be brought against it, and for any defense, settlement, or judgment against it. I will assume all liability for the actions of my dog in the event of such an incident.

Urban Hound, Inc. Policies

Application

Your dog must have a completed application and waiver of liability on file.

Age

Dogs may attend Urban Hound, Inc. as soon as their Veterinarian clears them for socialization. Urban Hound, Inc. has no age limit or size limit; however, we find that adolescent dogs seem to thrive best in the daycare environment.

Vaccinations / Health

Owners must verify that their dogs are clean, flea/tick free and in good health! Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition may be asked to provide a veterinarian's certification of health to be admitted or readmitted. All dogs will be required to have periodic fecal exams.

Dogs (six months of age and older) must have up to date vaccinations for the following: DHPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza and Parvovirus), Bordetella (Kennel cough) and Rabies. We require owners to submit written proof of their dog's vaccination records. They may be faxed to (253) 590-0857.

While we believe that the physical and psychological benefits of Dog Daycare far outweigh any potential risks. Dog owners must acknowledge that Just like children at school, dogs in daycare can catch whatever bug is going around. Keeping up to date on vaccinations can protect your pet from the more serious diseases, but dogs that socialize in large groups still pass around the occasional cough, sniffle, virus or parasite. Most of these communicable diseases are not serious. Healthy dogs with good diets and strong immune systems seem to be more resistant, and should be just fine.

Meet and Greet

All dogs must pass a meet and greet with an Urban Hound, Inc. staff member prior to attending daycare. The meet and greet is free of charge.

Feeding

We encourage you to feed your dog before and or after you bring them to daycare. If you would like your dog to be fed, there will be a \$4 charge per feeding for dogs six months of age and older. We require you to bring their regular food from home in individual portions, labeled with your dog's name.



Collars / Leashes

When entering Urban Hound, Inc., your dog must be on leash wearing a quick-release collar.

Behavior

All dogs must be non-aggressive or toy protective. Owners will need to verify that their dog has not harmed or shown any aggressive behavior towards any person or other dogs. Please remember, your pet will be spending time with other pets. Their health and safety is our main concern.

Accidents

From time to time accidents can occur. Keep in mind that dogs are sometimes unpredictable. Although Great care will be taken to ensure the safety of your dog, an occasional nip, scratch or broken nail is possible.

In the unlikely event of an emergency Urban Hound, Inc. staff will act on the owner's behalf at their sole discretion. The owner will assume all responsibility for any expenses involved.

Hours of Operation

Urban Hound, Inc. is open Monday – Friday from 6:30 AM to 6:30 PM. All dogs must be picked-up prior to closing!

We reserve the right to amend all policies, rates and hours of operation. We will do our best to update you with any changes and it is your responsibility to check with an Urban Hound, Inc. staff member or the website periodically to stay current with any and all revisions.
